



## *Beginner Classes now recognised.....*

As from 1<sup>st</sup> August 2016, the AAA Ltd will recognise Beginner Classes for those that are interested in starting out with their Appaloosas in Ridden Performance classes at both Regional Appaloosa Club and other recognised Shows.

To be eligible to obtain points from Beginner Events you must be a current financial member of the AAA Ltd and show a AAA Ltd Registered Appaloosa. **NOTE:** Please be aware of the Ownership requirements for Amateur Status.

You will require a Show Results Book to record your placings, these books are \$25.00 and can be purchased by contacting the AAA Ltd Office. Show results must be submitted within 21days of the show and a copy of the show program must accompany your results, **NO PROGRAM NO POINTS.**

At the end of the Season, High Point Awards will be given to the Open Beginner and Youth Beginner who have earned the most points in any recognised ridden performance Beginner Classes throughout the year.

So what makes you ineligible for these events?

- ❖ Competing in Beginner Events for 3 years.
- ❖ Winning 2 Beginner End of Year High Point Awards either at Club or AAA Ltd.
- ❖ Winning any other End of Year High Point Award either at Club or AAA Ltd.
- ❖ Winning a AA, State or National Championship class.
- ❖ Competing in any Feature Event at any show.

All AAA Ltd Affiliate clubs will have the option to run 2 Full Beginner Shows per season with either an Accredited or Non-Accredited Judge.
