

## PREFIX APPLICATION

\*\*Please refer to Rule 3.36 of the AAA Ltd Rule Book for the entire Prefix Rule\*\*

Application may only be made by a financial member of the AAA Ltd.

A Prefix is defined as a name or combination of letters (providing there are no fewer than two (2) letters) that is used to identify a members' horse.

If a word or combination of letters is used as an identifying word in a horse's name, in naming more than one (1) horse, it is deemed to be a prefix and must be registered as such, irrespective of owner(s) or breeder(s).

The name registered may be used as a Stud Prefix, but is essentially a Prefix to the name of a horse. However, it is not compulsory that it is used as a horse name Prefix.

The registrar has the right to approve or reject any application for a Prefix that is likely to be:

- a) Confused with an already registered Horse.
- b) Confused with an already registered Prefix.
- c) Deemed to be misleading to their sex.
- d) Deemed to be a common word.

Only the registered owner of a Prefix has the right to use that Prefix in the naming of a horse. Written permission is to be obtained should anyone other than the registered owner of the prefix wish to use it.

Members may register more than one (1) Prefix.
