Minimum Mandatory Performance Events:

Yearling – Halter, Hunter In Hand, Lungeline & Led Trail

2 Year Old – Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail**

(Exception – Any Show held between 1st August and 31st December in any year, 2yo ridden events are NOT PERMITTED.)**

Junior Horse – Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail

Senior Horse – Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail

NB: 3 year old events may also be included.

Any of the following:

Dressage, Hacking, Hunter In Hand, Reining, Western Horsemanship & Western Riding.

Minimum Amateur Sections & Events:

Novice Amateur – Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail
Amateur – Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail
Amateur Masters – Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail

Minimum Youth Age Divisions & Events:

13yrs & under Walk/Jog – Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail
13yrs & under – Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail
14 to 18yrs – Showmanship, Hunter Under Saddle, Western Pleasure & Trail

The following events are optional for Amateur and Youth:

Hunt Seat Equitation, Western Horsemanship, Dressage, Hack, Reining & Western Riding.

Any other event identified as “recognised” in rule 7.2 of the AAA Ltd Rule Book.

High Point Awards must be calculated as per Rule 5.26

In the event of a Tie for any High Point Award, please refer to Rule 5.29.

Your Judge must have one of the following qualifications - Open HSAA, Accredited AQHA or if using an International Judge, must hold one of the following breed Judges Tickets – ApHC, AQHA, NSBA or APHA – in their own country.

You must supply a list of all Horses, Owners, Amateurs and Youth who are entered in your show, **no less than 2 weeks prior** to the start of your show.

Once your show is over, you must supply results of all classes to 6th place within 30 days along with your completed Event Audit Report to the Association Office.
