



STALLION UPGRADE FORM

Colt to Stallion inspection forms.

Failure to upgrade prior to breeding carries penalty up to \$1000

The basis of this Veterinary Inspection is designed to determine the eligibility of a stallion as a registered sire for breeding.

AGE

Colts are eligible for upgrade from 1st August in the season in which they reach two (2) years of age.

METHOD OF UPGRADE

Colts and Stallions will be eligible for acceptance for Adult registration on the production of a signed

Veterinarian Inspection Report (see over) stating that the horse is: -

- NOT a Cryptorchid
- NOT a Monorchid
- NOT Parrot Mouthed
- HAS BOTH Testicles descended & evenly sized
- HAS NO visible signs of hereditary unsoundness
- THE HEIGHT of the horse must be stated

Signed veterinary inspection report and hard copy ID photo signed by the consulting veterinarian should be forwarded to the association office together with the required fee.

A further four(4), recent digital images (1 x near side, 1 x offside, 1 x rear view, 1 x front view) to be supplied to office.

An updated registration certificate will be provided along with a stallion service certificate book when all is in order.

The Progeny (colt) Recording Certificate must accompany the above.

At time of upgrade, results equivalent to 7 panel genetic tests must be provided as per AAA Rule 3.37

Your application must include the current registration papers.

Failure to upgrade prior to breeding carries penalty of up to \$1,000

FEES

\$600 Stallion Registration (includes Certificate of Service Book).

For Stallions which have not been Progeny Recorded, a late fee of \$140.00 must be added to the above.
